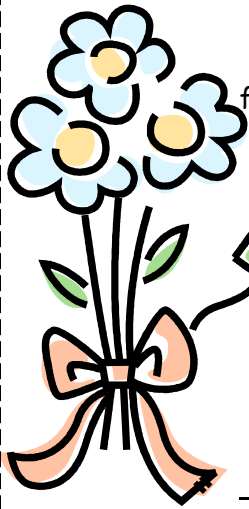
Envelopes must be returned to the red box by Wednesday May 20, 2009.
