## **GAMESATHON 2009**

Our school raises funds each year to support major educational programs and the school environment. Over the years, many improvements to the school and to the resources used by students have been made. The school air-conditioning has been paid for partly from Gamesathon funds. The proceeds of the Gamesathon have led to major up-grading of classroom equipment, additional Library books, extra resources for Kindergarten, classroom reading material and additional teaching time for students experiencing difficulties. This year, amongst many projects, we intend to continue to add to reading resources, purchase Data Projectors and an Interactive Whiteboard, replace old air conditioners, help with the electricity cost associated with the air conditioners and support the growth of the school Bands.

The Gamesathon will be the P&C's main fundraiser for 2009. It is the hope of the school and the P&C that every student will assist in our efforts to raise substantial funds for projects which will rapidly benefit students. **ALL** proceeds of the Gamesathon go to the P&C Association which then acts on behalf of parents to deploy funds quickly and effectively.

Students will collect pledges of support from as many people as possible and the payment will be collected after the Gamesathon. Students are not encouraged to go door-to-door and must always be mindful of their personal safety in collecting sponsors.

All collections of \$10 or more entitle the student to enter the draw for special prizes. On Friday September 25, five \$20 vouchers will be drawn from the tickets already collected. This will be repeated on Friday October 2. The more money collected gives you more tickets in the draw.

The Gamesathon for 2009 won't have a theme, however the children are allowed to wear their sports uniform or wear mufti.

### **Students will participate in 12 activities for K-2 and 13 for 3-6.**

- K-2 Gamesathon will commence at 10.20am and conclude at 12.10pm.
- The 3-6 Gamesathon will commence at 12.50pm and conclude by 2.40pm.

All boys and girls will be required to have a drink bottle with them and wear a hat.
