This excellent one man show explores the often overlooked insidious taunting and teasing that bullies are so adept at inflicting on their victims and the roles that family and schools can play in responding to this issue.

The play's charm, humour and quirky situations, together with its element of multi media, will inform and delight audiences.

Jack takes us on a touching and sometimes comical journey as it moves from victim to victor."
